# VIRTUAL CAMPING **TEACHERS GUIDE**

SESSION NAME:	INDIGENOUS TRAIL <b>GRADE 5 &amp; 6</b>
DURATION:	30 MINUTES

### **SESSION DESCRIPTION:**

This session walks you through the YMCA Anglesea Recreation Camp Indigenous Trail, where we look at the local Indigenous flora and fauna. There is an accompanying guiz sheet for students to fill out as they watch the session.
